Cancellation Policy:

Written cancellation notice is required and must be received by March 20, 2020. A 25% service fee will be retained on all cancellations. No refunds can be given after March 20, 2020. Cancellations received after March 20, and registrants who fail to attend the conference are liable for the full registration fees.

Substitution Policy:
