

WPC19 KY-TN WEA and KY/TN Section AWWA Scholarship

Award

The Kentucky/Tennessee Section of the American Water Works Association (AWWA) and the Kentucky-Tennessee Water Environment Association (WEA) will award four \$2,000 scholarships to eligible students pursuing a degree relating to the water industry. Two scholarships will be awarded to Kentucky residents and two scholarships will be awarded to Tennessee Residents.

The scholarships will provide reimbursement of tuition, books, and fees and will be distributed through the College/University bursar's office for use during the 2018-2019 academic year.

Eligibility

Full-time students attending an accredited Kentucky or Tennessee institution and currently majoring in an area related to the water environment industry are eligible. Student must have accumulated over 65 credit hours.

Application Process

1. Complete this application form and submit by May 17, 2019. This form does not allow you to save and return to your work, so please make sure to have all information available before you begin.
2. Mail your official college transcript(s) for all undergraduate and graduate courses to the following address by May 17, 2019. Applications without a transcript will not be considered.

Evaluation will be made on the basis of academic performance, work experience, community and civic activities, honors, involvement with AWWA/WEA organizations, and career goals.

Scholarship recipients will be selected by the Joint Scholarship Committee. The Committee will make a final selection of scholarship awardees by May 31, 2019.

Scholarship recipients will also receive a 1 year student membership to both AWWA and WEA.
