## WPC19 KY-TN WEA and KY/TN Section AWWA Scholarship

#### <u>Award</u>

The Kentucky/Tennessee Section of the American Water Works Association (AWWA) and the Kentucky-Tennessee Water Environment Association (WEA) will award four \$2,000 scholarships to eligible students pursuing a degree relating to the water industry.
