

Video Presentation of Your Project Instructions

At the SJWP national competition, judges from the national jury are assigned certain students to interview. To allow all members of the national jury the opportunity to see every project, we are requiring students prepare and upload a video, no longer than three (3) minutes, explaining their project as they would for the judges. This can also serve as a practice round for the students, plus they can practice and upload their best version! Instructions are as follows:

- 1) Rules for the video:
 - a. Videos must not be longer than 3 minutes
 - b. Begin video by stating your name(s), the state you are representing, and the title of your project
 - c. Explain your project as you would to the judges

- 2) Please note that this video does NOT need to be professionally produced; you will not get any brownie points for having it done so; the video can be done with a camera or a smartphone, outside, inside, at the kitchen table...it doesn't matter. The objective is solely to give ALL judges the opportunity to have an idea of what your project is about. You also do not need to be dressed in business attire, appropriate casual clothing is just fine.

- 3) To upload your video, please follow these instructions:

 - c. Click on Upload and upload your video

The deadline for entering your video is May 22th. This is a non-negotiable date, as the judges will need as much time as possible to view all of the videos and form their questions for the one-on-one interviews.
